Bank balance as of 01 July 2026: The Foundation holds approximately **₹3.69 Lakhs**, of which around **₹3.19 Lakhs** represents donations and contributions received from our supporters. **₹.50 Lakh** is contribution of founders.

Operational expenses to date: The Foundation has incurred only approximately **₹5,000** in total operational and administrative costs — covering essential office expenses, basic administrative requirements, and necessary overheads. Every decision on expenditure is made with the intent of preserving maximum funds for welfare work. We are still yet to add expense of Razor pay subscription and charges.

Our Approach — Deliberate, Not Delayed

The Foundation has made a conscious decision **not to rush into projects for the sake of visibility or optics**. We are all too familiar with organisations that announce initiatives before they have the capacity to deliver them meaningfully. That is not the path we will take.

Our belief is simple: **when we commit to supporting an individual or a cause, that support must be substantial, sustained, and capable of creating genuine change**. A one-time gesture is not impact. Verified, consistent, and financially backed intervention is.

To that end, the Foundation intends to launch major welfare programmes once the corpus reaches a **sustainable threshold of approximately ₹25 Lakhs**. This is not an arbitrary number — it represents our assessment of the minimum financial base required to make a real, lasting difference in the lives of soldiers, veterans, Veer Naris, and their families.

What We Are Building Right Now

While we prepare the Foundation for meaningful deployment, our present efforts are focused on five foundational priorities:

- Establishing deep connections with Army establishments, regimental centres, and veteran networks across the country — building the relationships that will help us reach those who truly need support
- Identifying, verifying, and documenting genuine cases of soldiers, veterans, Veer Naris, and dependent families requiring assistance — so that when support begins, it reaches the right people
- Building transparent, auditable operational and due-diligence processes — ensuring every rupee is traceable, purposeful, and accounted for publicly
- Consulting and learning from experienced individuals and organisations who have spent years working in veterans' welfare and social impact — so we build on proven frameworks, not assumptions
- Spreading awareness about the Foundation's mission and its cause, through outreach and communication, to encourage wider public participation and strengthen our fund-collection efforts
